DAY 01 (Saturday) – IN / MEXICO CITY

DAY 02 (Sunday) – MEXICO CITY – GUADALAJARA – City tour

Upon arrival, we will tour Guadalajara, visiting the Cathedral, the Rotunda of Illustrious Men, the Degollado Theater, Plaza Tapatia, and enjoying a panoramic view of the Hospicio Cabañas, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

DAY 03 (Monday) – GUADALAJARA – Tequila - Tlaquepaque

After this visit, we will continue to San Pedro Tlaquepaque, a town near Guadalajara that is now part of the city. The inhabitants of this town are dedicated to glassblowing, and you can also find spectacular handicrafts of all kinds. Return to Guadalajara.

DAY 04 (Tuesday) – GUADALAJARA – Guanajuato – SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE

Departure for Guanajuato, a UNESCO World Heritage city and home to the annual Cervantine International Festival. In the afternoon, we'll explore this beautiful city, with its charming alleyways and plazas, and discover fascinating sites such as the University, the Juarez Theater, the Alley of the Kiss, and the Diego Rivera House-Museum, the home of muralist Diego Rivera, husband of Frida Kahlo. We'll also explore its unique underground streets and avenues. In the mid-afternoon, we'll continue our journey to San Miguel de Allende.

DAY 05 (Wednesday) – SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE – Queretaro – MEXICO CITY

DAY 06 (Thursday) – MEXICO CITY - City tour + Museum of Anthropology or Chapultepec Castle



Breakfast at the hotel

We will visit the most representative places in this city. The first part is on foot. The Plaza de la Constitución, or Zocalo, is the third largest square in the world. On its sides, we will find the first attractions we will see: The National Palace, the Metropolitan Cathedral, the largest church in Latin America, where we can appreciate, among other things, the famous "Santo Cristo del Veneno" or "Black Christ." Next to the Cathedral are the ruins of the Templo Mayor, which is precisely the heart of the birth of Great Tenochtitlan, which we will view from the outside. From here, we will admire Paseo de la Reforma from the vehicle, with its Independence Monument commonly called "El Angel". If the authorities allow it, we can get out to take a photograph with Mexico's most important monument. We will continue along Reforma to locate and admire from the vehicle Chapultepec Forest, where the Castle, which was the residence of Emperor Maximilian and Mexican presidents, the Lake, and the National Auditorium are located.

Option 1: Visit the National Museum of Anthropology, where you can appreciate a mosaic of the country's most important cultures.

Option 2: Visit the National Museum of History, also known as Chapultepec Castle, the former residence of Emperor Maximilian.

You can remain at the museum to explore it fully or be transferred back to your hotel.
