ITINERARY

OCT 30 – IN / CIUDAD DE MÉXICO – Transfer to the hotel



Arrival at the international airport in Mexico City. Reception and transfer to your hotel.

Check in at hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

Lunch and dinner at leisure. **Lodging**

OCT 31 – CIUDAD DE MÉXICO – Z.A. Teotihuacan + City Tours



Breakfast at the hotel.

Visit to the Archaeological Zone of San Juan de Teotihuacan, considered one of the most important pre-Hispanic sites discovered to date. We will visit the Pyramid of the Sun (the largest pyramid), the Pyramid of the Moon, the Road of the Dead and the Temple of Quetzalcoatl (the feathered serpent). **Buffet lunch.**

We will continue with a panoramic visit of Paseo de la Reforma Avenue where we will be able to observe its monuments such as the Aztec Tlatoani Cuauhtémoc and the Independence Column, we will continue until we reach the historic Chapultepec forest and the residential area where we will be able to observe some famous houses and others where famous soap operas and movies were filmed (panoramic visit). We will go to the Historic Center to visit the Metropolitan Cathedral, the Main Square also known as Zocalo and the Government Palace (visit from the outside, no access), as well as the archaeological ruins of the Templo Mayor of the Aztecs. We



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will finish with a visit to a handicraft market to learn about the folklore of Mexican handicrafts. Return to the hotel.

NOV 01 – CIUDAD DE MÉXICO – Basílica de Guadalupe

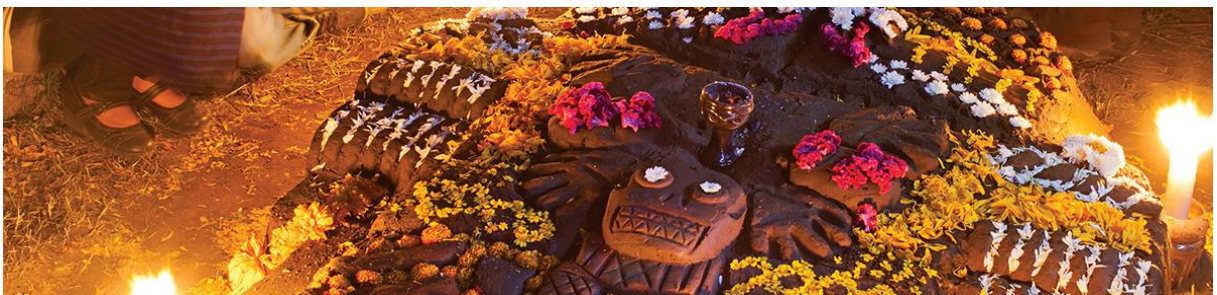


Breakfast at the hotel

We will continue to the PLAZA de las TRES CULTURAS (Square of the Three Cultures), a panoramic visit of the place where the three eras that the country has lived: Pre-Hispanic, Colonial and Modern. Then we will visit the Basilica of Guadalupe where the Patroness of Mexico is venerated. Return to the hotel and free afternoon.

NOV 02 – CIUDAD DE MÉXICO – Xochimilco + San Antonio Tecómitl



Breakfast at the hotel

We will start the day moving to the south of the city to the house of a family in the area of Xochimilco, to learn the meaning of an ofrenda and be part of this tradition, with the creation of this altar for our dead, dialogue with their memory, with their life and have a reunion as a ritual that calls to memory.



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The Day of the Dead offering is a cultural mix where the Europeans put some flowers, waxes, candles and candles; the indigenous people added the incense with their copal and the food and the cempasúchil flower (Zempoalxóchitl). The offering, as we know it today, is also a reflection of the syncretism of the old and the new world. The dead are received with natural, frugal and intangible elements - we include here the trails of scents and fragrances that come from flowers, incense and copal (we invite you to bring a portrait of your deceased).

Later transfer to the Nuevo Nativitas Pier in Xochimilco, "Place of flowers", it has an attraction that has given it international fame for being unique in the world: the chinampas, an ancient and very productive agricultural technique used by the Xochimilcas since pre-Hispanic times and consisting of artificial islands created on the lake. We will take a boat that will take us to tour its canals. **Lunch fixed menu on board.**

We will finish with a visit to the town of San Antonio Tecómitl; one of the 12 original towns that make up Milpa Alta. Here the celebration of "All Saints" takes place in the town's cemetery, where early in the morning families begin to gather to clean the graves of their deceased. Around 3:00 p.m. they begin the work of kneading and creating a muddy paste; everywhere you can see sculptors giving life to the dead. With a lot of ingenuity and only their hands they squeeze the mounds of wet earth to mold skulls in all shapes and sizes. Walking among the tombs and the earth sculptures, decorated with cempasúchil flowers, fleece and velvet, one breathes the sentiment in some and the joy in others. Return to Mexico City.

Dinner at leisure. **Lodging**

NOV 03 – CIUDAD DE MÉXICO / OUT

Breakfast at the hotel.

At a convenient time, transfer from your hotel to the Mexico City international airport to take your flight to your destination.
