## ITINERARY

### DAY 01– IN / CIUDAD DE MÉXICO



**Arrival at Mexico City International Airport.** Reception and transfer to your hotel.

**Check in at the hotel.** Rest of the day at leisure.

Lunch and dinner on your own. **Lodging.**

### DAY 02 – CIUDAD DE MÉXICO – Querétaro – SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE



**Breakfast at the hotel.**

Departure to Queretaro, a World Heritage City, where we will visit the Aqueduct, the Ex-Convent of the Cross and the Historic Center. We will continue on to San Miguel de Allende. Afternoon to visit this peaceful city where the great comedian Mario Moreno "Cantinflas" lived and a place of residence for artists and intellectuals. Highlights include the Parish of San Miguel Arcangel, the Chapel of the Holy House, the Convent of the Conception, the Church of San Francisco and the Allende House and Institute. You will find a wide variety of cafes and restaurants to choose from.

**DAY 03 – SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE – Dolores Hidalgo – GUANAJUATO**



**Breakfast at the hotel.**

Departure to Dolores Hidalgo, where the priest Don Miguel Hidalgo gave the "Cry of Independence" of Mexico in 1810. There we will find the house-museum of this national hero. We will continue to Guanajuato, a World Heritage City, home of the annual Cervantino International Festival. In the afternoon we will enjoy this beautiful city, full of alleys and squares, which offers us very interesting places such as the University, the Juarez Theater, the Kiss Alley, the house-museum of the muralist Diego Rivera, husband of Frida Kahlo. Its streets and subway avenues are unique in the country. Other attractive options are: the "callejoneada" accompanied by a musical estudiantina or tuna valenciana, the house of Jorge Negrete, the museum of Don Quixote and the Mummies.
