DAY 01 – IN / SALTILLO



Arrival at Saltillo International Airport. Reception and transfer to your hotel.

Check in at hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 02 – SALTILLO – Viesca y Parras de la Fuente



Breakfast at the hotel.

In the morning we will visit the Magical Town of Viesca where we will visit the Dunes of Bilbao, the Church of Santiago Apostle, the Main Square, the Old Tree where Miguel Hidalgo rested. At the end of the afternoon transfer to the town of Parras. Where we will have the opportunity to visit the oldest winery in America visiting the Historic Center and other attractions of Pueblo Magico: Casa Madero, Fuantos Segovia Wines, the World's Largest Pants, La Parvada Wines, Campechanas Factory, Plaza de Reloj, Presidency, Alameda, Santo Madero Church, El Perote Wines, Purchase of Sotol.

DAY 03 – SALTILLO - Arteaga



Breakfast at the hotel.

You will visit this peaceful and cheerful town full of orchards, located in the middle of the Sierra de Coahuila, where it rises like an island in the middle of the great desert that identifies this northern region of the country, to conquer you with beautiful wooded landscapes, a delicious smell of fruits and a spectacular mountain range.

First you will visit the Temple of San Isidro Labrador de las Palomas, this one presents in its facade two bodies decorated with thick pilasters that frame three niches, in the first one you can appreciate some little angels, in the second one the window of the choir and in the third one the image of Jesus Christ is housed, while an old clock tops the tower; Carranza house, has a collection of historical photos of the place; the Municipal Presidency and the mural Canto de Esperanza by Eloy Cerecero, dedicated to the manifesto. To the Mexican town of Venustiano Carranza.

DAY 04 – SALTILLO – General de Cepeda

Tour of the Municipal Presidency, which was once the main house of the Hacienda de San Francisco de Patos, Administrative Headquarters of the Marquis of Aguayo, visit the Temple of San Francisco and the Molino Quemado, a site where the apparitions of the Marquis are recurrent and to finish our tour in this interesting town we will visit the Museum of History Atlahuaco.
