DEC 09 – IN / MEXICO CITY



Arrival at Mexico City International Airport.

Reception and transfer from the airport to the hotel. Check-in. Rest of the day at leisure. At the convenient time **DINNER (set menu for 3 courses without drinks).**

DEC 10 – MEXICO CITY – Santa María Tonantzintla – Puebla



Breakfast at the hotel.

Early departure to the **Church of Santa María Tonantzintla**. This jewel of indigenous Baroque architecture dazzles with its richly decorated interior. Its interior is a riot of colors, figures, and symbols that fuse Catholic faith with the pre-Hispanic worldview. Dedicated to the Virgin Mary, considered in this region as the Mother of all people—Tonantzin in Nahuatl—the church represents the deep devotion of the people and the union between two cultures through faith. It is a sacred place that continues to be a point of spiritual encounter and artistic admiration.

Continue to Puebla, a city that has been an important religious center since its origins, home to numerous churches, convents, and chapels that safeguard invaluable sacred art. Beyond its architecture and traditions, Puebla is a destination where spirituality and history intertwine, inviting you to experience faith, culture, and beauty. We will visit its majestic Cathedral and stroll through its emblematic streets. **Buffet lunch (drinks not included).** Return to Mexico City.

DEC 11– MEXICO CITY – City tour – Guadalupe Shrine



Breakfast at the hotel.

Transfer to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe to begin the celebrations with the **solemn Lauds (8:30 a.m.)**, a morning prayer dedicated to Our Lady of Guadalupe, where the clergy and faithful give thanks for a new day under her protection. Afterward, we will participate in the Guadalupe Chapter (9:00 a.m.), a traditional ceremony led by the canons of the Basilica, who pay formal homage to the Virgin of Guadalupe with songs, offerings, and words of devotion. Both moments reflect the profound spirituality and respect with which Mexico honors its patron saint, marking the beginning of a day filled with faith, love, and gratitude. At the end of the celebration, we will take our city tour. **Lunch at a local restaurant (drinks not included)**. Return to the hotel. Around 9:00 PM, transfer from the hotel to the Basilica of Guadalupe. Every year, the festivities begin on the eve of December 12th with the singing of "Las Mañanitas" by famous artists in homage to the Virgin. At the appropriate time, departure from the Basilica and return to the hotel.

DEC 12– MEXICO CITY– Guadalupe Shrine – Xochimilco

We will return to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe to participate in the **Mass of the Roses**, which commemorates the Guadalupe miracle, when the image of the Virgin appeared on Juan Diego's tilma amidst a blanket of roses. During this moving ceremony, thousands of faithful place flowers before her altar as a sign of love and gratitude, while traditional songs are sung and Mexico's deepest devotion is rekindled. It is a unique experience that combines faith, tradition, and the fervor of millions of pilgrims who come from all over the country to honor the Queen of Mexico. (Flowers, candles, and banner included).

DEC 13–MEXICO CITY – Pyramids of Teotihuacan



Breakfast at the hotel.

Just an hour from Mexico City lies Teotihuacan, "the place where men become gods." We will visit this majestic archaeological site, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, which dazzles with its imposing Pyramids of the Sun and Moon, and the iconic Avenue of the Dead, evoking the grandeur of one of Mesoamerica's most powerful civilizations. Beyond its historical significance, Teotihuacan is considered a place brimming with energy and spirituality, where visitors from around the world come to admire its beauty, feel its mystical power, and connect with Mexico's deepest roots. After the visit, return to Mexico City. In the evening, we'll head to Plaza Garibaldi. The restaurant offers tourists a Mexican show featuring a folkloric ballet, performances by ranchera singers, a rope-twirling demonstration, and a simulated cockfight, all accompanied by traditional mariachi music. **A glass of Mexican beverage is included.** Return to the hotel.
